

One of the world's biggest statues, Garuda Wisnu Kencana, has been constructed in Bali, and it's already looking impressive. The gigantic monument of the Hindu God of providence Wisnu riding the mythical bird Garuda is around 120 m high (including a concrete pedestal) and 64 m wide. To put this in perspective, New York's Statue of Liberty stands at 93 m. The tallest statue in the world is statue at Spring Temple Buddha monument in Henan, China, 128 m.

Garuda Wisnu Kencana has been in the making for the past two decades, with the work resuming in 2013 after a 16 year hiatus due to financial woes. Masterminded by a renowned Balinese sculptor I Nyoman Nuarta, the partially-completed statue is already the highlight of the tr, 240-hectare Garuda Wisnu Kencana Cultural Park on the island's southern coast. Wisnu's massive upper body, as well as Garuda's head and claws have been attracting scores of local and foreign visitors to the park for a good few years now. While the final monument is made from over 4000 tons of copper, brass and steel, its parts are currently being fashioned by Nuarta at his Bandung workshop in Java before being transported over 1000 km by trucks for installation.

Opened in 1997 to house the colossal sculpture, the Garuda Wisnu Kencana Cultural Park plays host to regular gatherings and events, and features a lotus pond, an amphitheatre and an exhibition area.

Making coloured and scented candles is really quick and simple. What's more, you'll save so much money. If making candle is easy, why do you ever bought one from a shop?

What you need in making candle are **wax, moulds, wick, dye discs, essential oils**, and a **double boiler**. All these materials are available from craft shops. Or if you do not want to buy them, you can improvise with an old saucepan, pyrex jug, or even a sturdy can, in a pot of water. After providing the materials, follow this procedure or instruction in making candles!

..., **melt the wax**. All wax has a flash point, so to prevent it bursting into flames, you must melt it in a double boiler, with water in the bottom pan.

Then, prepare the mould with the wick. Thread the wick through the mould and make sure that you leave a good few centimetres sticking out of the hole in the bottom.

After that, add the scent. If you want a scented candle, add a few drops of essential oil to the melted wax. You can use any essential oil you like, as long as it doesn't contain water.

Next step, pour the wax into the mould. Try and tip the wax into the mould quickly, all in one go, to minimise spillage and air bubbles.

Then, release the bubbles and top it

up. Releasing the air bubbles will eventually make the candle sink, so you will need to top it up with more melted wax.

Finally, remove it from the mould after four or five hours.

Your candle is now ready for display. Remember, you must always leave it for a day before lighting it.

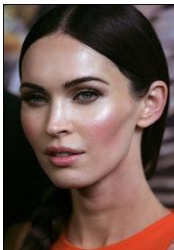

Megan Fox was born on May 16, 1986 in Oak Ridge, Tennessee to parents Gloria Darlene (Cisson) and Franklin Thomas Fox. She spent her early childhood in nearby Rockwood. Fox's father, a parole officer, and her mother divorced when Fox was three years old. Her mother later remarried, and Fox and her sister were raised by her mother and her stepfather, Tony Tonachio. She was raised "very strictly Pentecostal", but later attended Catholic school for 12 years. She said that the two were "very strict" and that she was not allowed to have a boyfriend or invite friends to her house. She lived with her mother until she made enough money to support herself.

When she was 13 years old, Fox began modeling after winning several awards at the 1999 American Modeling and Talent Convention in Hilton Head, South Carolina. At age 17, she tested out of school via correspondence in order to move to Los Angeles, California

Fox made her acting debut in the 2001 film *Holiday in the Sun*, as spoiled heiress Brianna Wallace and rival of Alex Stewart, which was released direct-to-DVD on November 20, 2001. In the next several years she guest-starred on What I Like About You and Two and a Half Men, as well as being an unaccredited extra in Bad Boys II (2003).

In 2004, she made her film debut in *Confessions of a Teenage Drama Queen* co-starring opposite Lindsay Lohan, playing the

supporting role of Carla Santini, a rival of Lola (Lohan). Fox was also cast in a regular role on the ABC sitcom *Hope & Faith*, in which she portrayed Sydney Shanowski, replacing Nicole Paggi. Fox appeared in seasons 2 to 3, until the show was cancelled by ABC in May 2006.

In 2009, Fox had her first lead role since the *Transformers* series; she portrayed the title character in *Jennifer's Body*, written by Academy Award-winning screenwriter Diablo Cody.

On October 29, 2017, it was announced that Fox would appear in the upcoming pre-production film, "Shadow Girl", beside Olivia Thirlby and Alan Ritchson.

On September 12, 2018, it was confirmed that Fox would star in the upcoming Korean war film *Battle of Jangsa-ri 9.15* beside Korean actor Kim Myung-min. She will play a lead role as an American news reporter.

Lizard is the animals that belong to reptile that has scales and four legs. Based on the size of the body, these animals are classified into two groups that are small-bodied lizards like home lizards, sand lizards, geckos, and big-bodied lizard such as *Biawak*, and *Komodo*. Large-bodied lizard's length can reach more than 3 m. Lizard's body is generally filled by scales but some are smooth and shiny like type of *Infraordo Scincomorpha*. This animal belongs to cold-bodied animals. They need sun to regulate their body temperature.

Lizard has various places to live. Most of lizards live on the land (terrestrial), some of them lives inside soil or sand (tonsorial) while some snake hangs around on the top or in the trunk of the tree (arboreal). They are the explorer animal. They actively explore the environment to hunt their prey.

Although most of this species are predator, but actually lizard's food is very varied. They can eat fruits; seeds, insects, amphibians, reptiles, and

mammals. Even komodo can eat prey which is larger than its body. Most lizards reproduce by spawning such as home lizard and Komodo dragon but some reproduces by yeaning.

They are not dangerous for humans. It is generally useful for humans as pest control, pet, medicine and much more. However, there are also several types of them that are harmful to humans such as Komodo and Biawak. There are even lizards that have very strong poison such as Giant Mad Lizard and Beads Lizard which can be found in Mexico.
