How to Make Ice Cream

You need these ingredients to make ice cream :

- ✤ 2 cups milk (not skim) or cream
- ✤ 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon Vanilla extract (can substitute other flavoring.)
- Several cups of Ice (the smaller the pieces, the better)
- * 1 cup salt (rock salt is best, but table salt can also be used)

You need these supplies to make ice cream :

- * Tub or large coffee can to hold salt and ice
- Glass bowl or small coffee can
- Electric mixer or whisk
- Ice cream scoop
- ✤ Storage container for freezer

Here are the instructions that you must follow :

- 1. Set up the cooling apparatus. Stir ice and salt in the larger container. Double-check that the small container will fit into the larger one even with the ice.
- 2. Combine the ingredients. Mix together the milk, sugar, and vanilla in the glass bowl. Then, set this bowl in the tub filled with ice and rock salt. Make sure that the salt water does not spill into the bowl. Instead of a glass bowl and tub, you can also use a small coffee can inside a large coffee can.
- 3. Mix the ice cream. Mix the ingredients in the small container vigorously. The salty ice mixture will cool the mixture down until it turns into ice cream. Mix very thoroughly. If you're using a whisk instead of an electric mixer in your glass bowl, you'll have to stir very hard, or ice crystals will form in the ice cream. If you are using the coffee can method, make sure both cans are well sealed, and then roll and shake to mix the ice cream mixture. It should take about 10 to 15 minutes to stir the ice cream using either method. Stir until it is free from ice crystals and is the right consistency.
- 4. Store and serve. If you don't eat the ice cream right away, be sure to store it in the freezer so that it doesn't melt.

There are three natural causes of landslides. Earthquakes are seismic activities that have always been a main cause of landslides throughout the world. Any time plate tectonics move the soil that covers them moves with it. When earthquakes occur on areas with steep slopes, many times the soil slips causing landslides. Furthermore, ashen debris flows caused by earthquakes can also trigger mass movement of soil. Heavy rainfall occurs when sloped areas become completely saturated by heavy rainfall many times landslides can occur. Without the aid of mechanical root supports the soil simply runs off when it contains too much water.

Human activities such as clear cutting and mining also contribute to the causes of landslides. Clear cutting is the method of timber harvesting which completely removes all old growth timber from the area. This method is hazardous because it destroys the existing mechanical root structure in the area. Mining operations that use blasting techniques often cause other areas that are at the risk of sliding to slide due to vibrations under the soil.



JACK JOHNSON

Jack Johnson was one of nine children born to a couple of ex-slaves, and rose from those humble beginnings to become the first ever African American heavy weight boxing champion of the world. The young Jack played with white children as a boy in Galveston, Texas, never feeling discriminated against in those early years. Perhaps this gave him strength and self-belief in the face of the racism he would encounter later in life.

Johnson spent only a few years in school before taking on a series of manual jobs. He travelled to New York and then Boston as a 16-year-old, taking on more jobs and engaging in his first fight - which he won - against an older and bigger longshoreman. Many more fights were to follow, and Johnson became the 'Colored Heavyweight Champion of the World'. His attempts to fight for the World Championship were repeatedly foiled as white opponents refused to fight him. Finally his efforts paid off when Canadian Tommy Burns was tempted into a fight for an enormous purse. Johnson won and would reign undefeated for seven years. A succession of 'Great White Hopes' failed to beat Johnson during this time, as White America felt humiliated by this black champion.

Even out of the ring Johnson refused to conform to the racist beliefs of the time, openly dating (and marrying) white women, which caused outrage in the eyes of many. Jack was forced to keep fighting well into his 50s (possibly even his 60s) in order to earn money, as his color made it hard to make a living any other way. Even his death could be put down to racism, as he died in a car crash after racing away from a dinner that refused to serve him. However, despite all his struggles, Jack Johnson remained a symbol of hope, a man who allowed African Americans to walk taller during a time of extreme prejudice.

Bukit Batu, which was believed to be the place of Burut Ules's residence, now better known as the Hermitage for National Hero and Central Kalimantan Hero Tjilik Riwut, located in Central Kalimantan. Currently, by the Government of Central Kalimantan, it has been established as a spiritual attractions.
